Here's how your donation can help:

\$10K (or more) = Provides a part-time music therapist (20 hours a week) for our Traditional or Memory Care residents.

\$5K = Provide one month of subsidy for one qualified assisted living resident at the Saab Residence. The typical assisted living in the Lowell area costs about \$7,500 a month. Most residents who are a part of our subsidy program pay less than \$2,000 a month. We project that in 2025, the program will subsidize approximately \$1.5 million to keep older people in their home, with the care they need.

\$2K = Pet therapy & programming for our traditional and memory care residents, once a month in 2025!

\$1,000 = 8 to 10 musical performances, pet therapy interactions and other activities or our residents.

\$500 = 10 visits from our Chair Yoga specialist for traditional and memory care residents.

\$175 = Help us fill the D'Youville Bus with a full tank of Gas to transport our residents to shop, or experience fun excursions such as dining out, or a trip to the beach.

\$150 = 1 visit or performance from various artists and musicians to enhance or own activity programs.

\$100 = Provide extra refreshments, holiday decorations and other enhancements to make our activities special all year long.

\$25 = Consider making a monthly pledge of \$25 or more to help seniors on our campus!
